Vision Statement:

Goal:

To create a safe and welcoming atmosphere used to guide our families through the kids check-in process.

Prepare:

God has gifted each of us individually so that, when we work together, we can build up the church and bring glory to Him. Look for ways to use your gifts every time you serve. Pray for God to open doors for you to communicate the gospel through your volunteering. Remember, our desire to serve should come from the overflow of our relationship with Christ and our desire to be like Him.

Schedule:

- Be at the pre-service VIP meeting at your campus.
- Be in position to serve 25 minutes before each service.
- Prepare the check-in computers before our guests arrive.

Kids Check-In Team Requirements:

- A background check is required to be on file at the church before serving in any of our kids areas. This background check is done at the cost of the church.

Kids Check-In Team Reminders:

- Remember that every volunteer position at Hope Community Church helps to communicate the message of the gospel to our guests. Your words and actions matter.
- Our Kids Check-In volunteers play an important role in helping families feel welcome and comfortable during drop off time. Look for ways to create genuine connections with our guests while you guide them through the check-in process.
- Be familiar with the check-in computers and the process of adding new guests.
- Please dress appropriately.
- Always be the first to say “hello”. Make eye contact. Be genuine and welcoming.
- Be intentional about learning guests’ names each week. Introduce yourself to any new guests during check-in time.
- Look for ways to go above and beyond in serving our guests each week.
- Please remain in your serving area until the first 10 minutes of our worship service is finished to allow time for all of our guests to check-in their children.
- We value your commitment to your volunteer position. Please let your Team Leader know if you will be absent.
